

**Announcement of EPS Quantum Electronics and Optics Prizes 2005

**The EPS Quantum Electronics and Optics Prizes**

These two prizes are awarded on a biannual basis, for outstanding contributions to quantum electronics and optics. One prize is for Fundamental Aspects, the other for Applied Aspects. Nominators should be members of the EPS, however this is not a requirement on the nominees. EPS members are urged to give this matter their thought and attention, as this is an important opportunity for the membership to contribute to the affairs of EPS and of Quantum Electronics and Optics Division (QEOD)

## **AWARD NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR BOTH PRIZES**

1. Completed award nomination form. The form is found below. (It can also be found at the QEOD website: go to <http://www.eps.org> , click on Divisions and Groups, then on the home page of QEOD). The form can be completed electronically (if the WORD version of this document is used), then printed and signed by the nominator.
2. A brief, (30 word max), citation stating the scientific achievements that qualify the nominee for this award, to be entered on the nomination form.
3. On a separate page a statement of the nominees major scientific achievements ( $\frac{1}{2}$  page max).
4. The nominees CV (1 page max).
5. A list (1 page max) of the nominees most important publications.
6. Letters of support (minimum 2, maximum 3) from referees of your choice. Maximum length of any letter is 2 pages. Contact information for each of the referees should also be supplied on the nomination form.
7. Full contact information for the nominee on the nomination form.
8. Birth date (only needed for Fresnel Prize nominees) on the nomination form.
9. Your signature as nominator together with your contact information on the nomination

form.
